





Legalized Marijuana

Colorado:

- Traffic deaths in which drivers tested positive for marijuana increased 109% while all traffic deaths increased 31%
- DUIDs increased from 1,902 in 2014 to 3,083 in 2018

Montana:

• About a 20% increase in THC related DUI's year-over-year from 2019
