UCFRB Aquatic Restoration Plan Goals

1

Restore the mainstems trout fishery by improving recruitment of fish from tributaries. 2

Replace lost trout angling in the mainstems by improving trout populations in the tributaries.

3

Maintain or improve native trout populations in the Upper Clark Fork River Basin to preserve rare and diverse gene pools and improve the diversity and resiliency of the trout fishery.

Restore injured terrestrial resources and associated ecological and recreational services (hunting, wildlife viewing, other outdoor recreation).



Replace injured terrestrial resources by protecting and enhancing habitat.



Replace lost hunting, wildlife viewing, other outdoor recreation and ensure public access to these resources.




