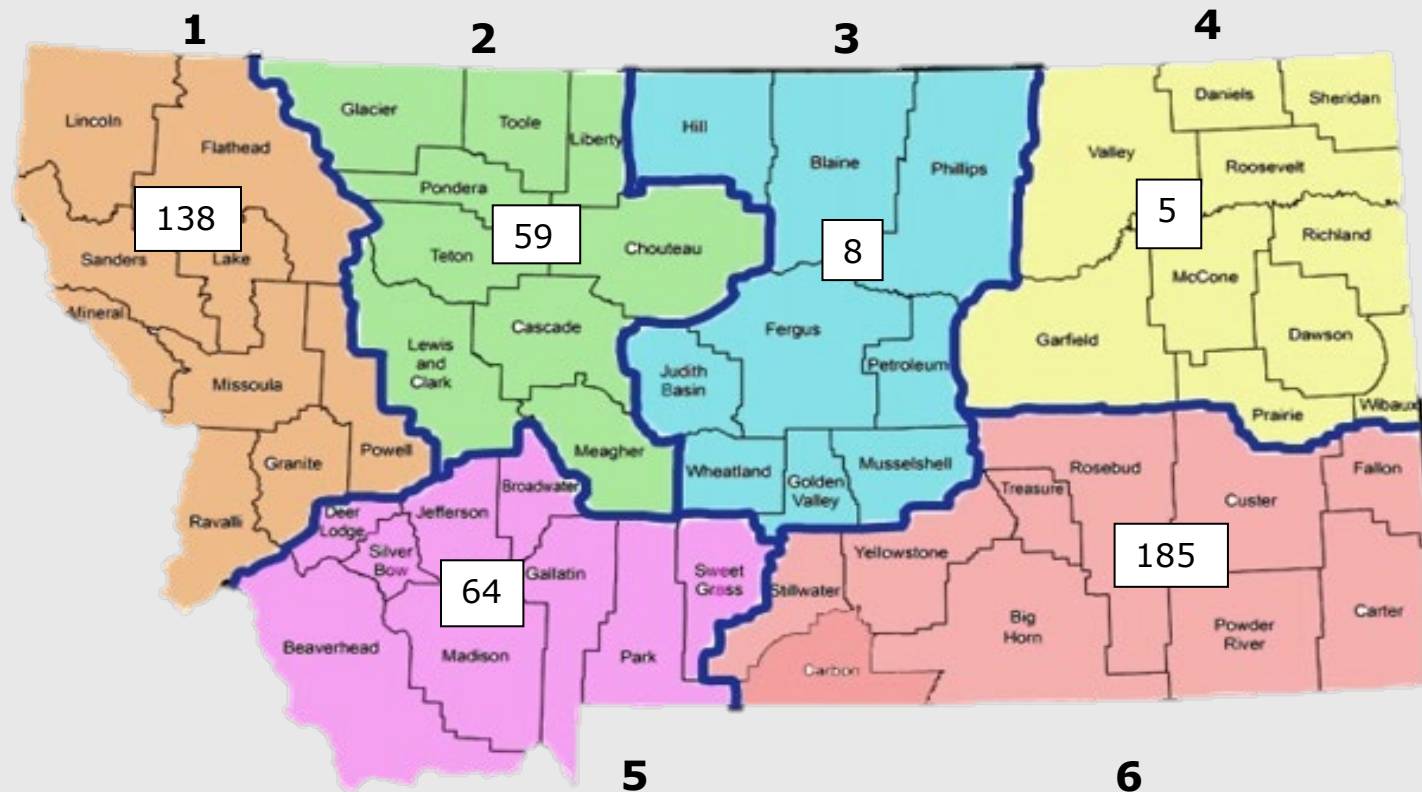
# Sexual Assault Kits from Juvenile Victims by Montana Regions and Counties

459

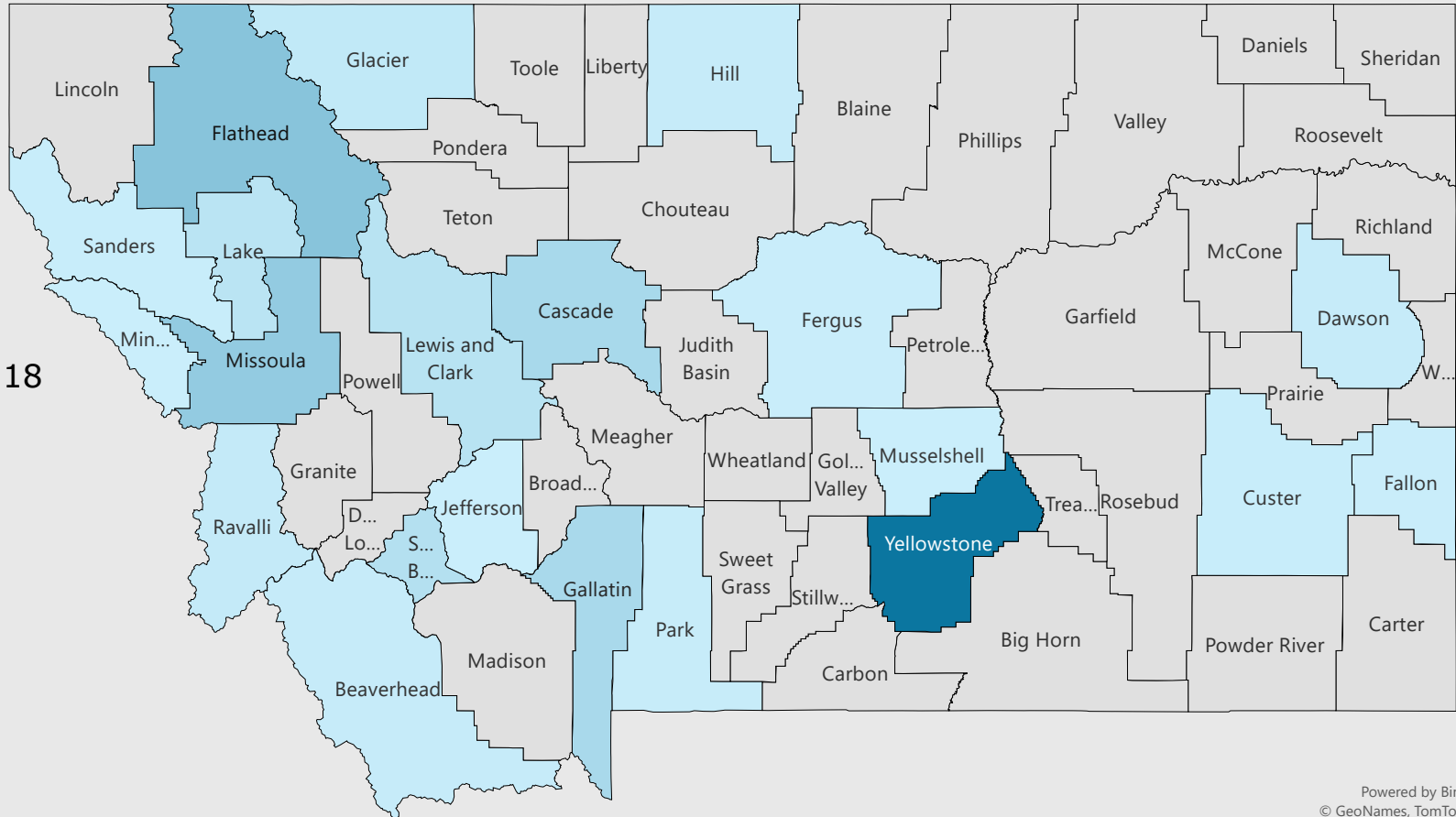

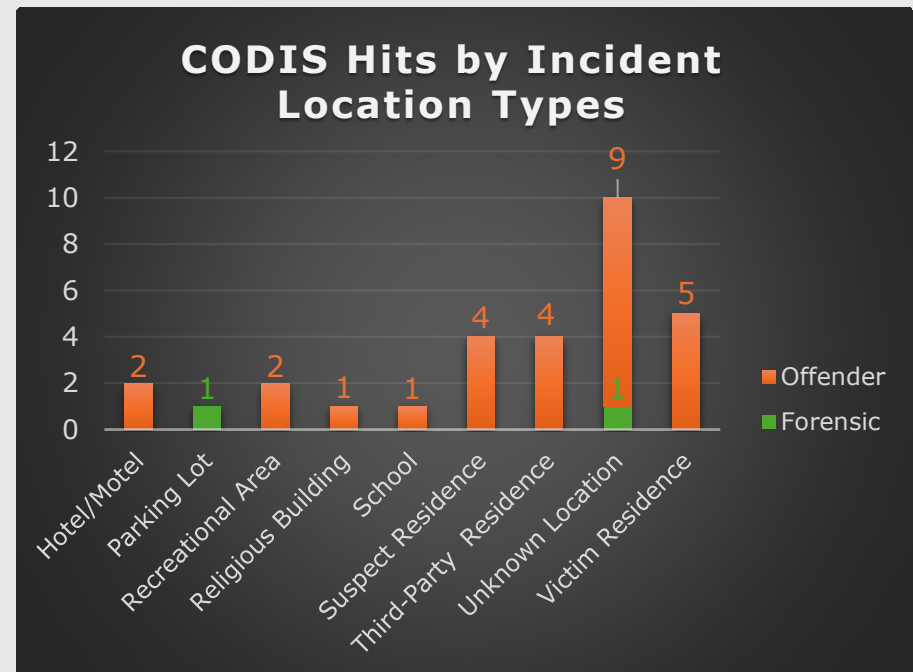
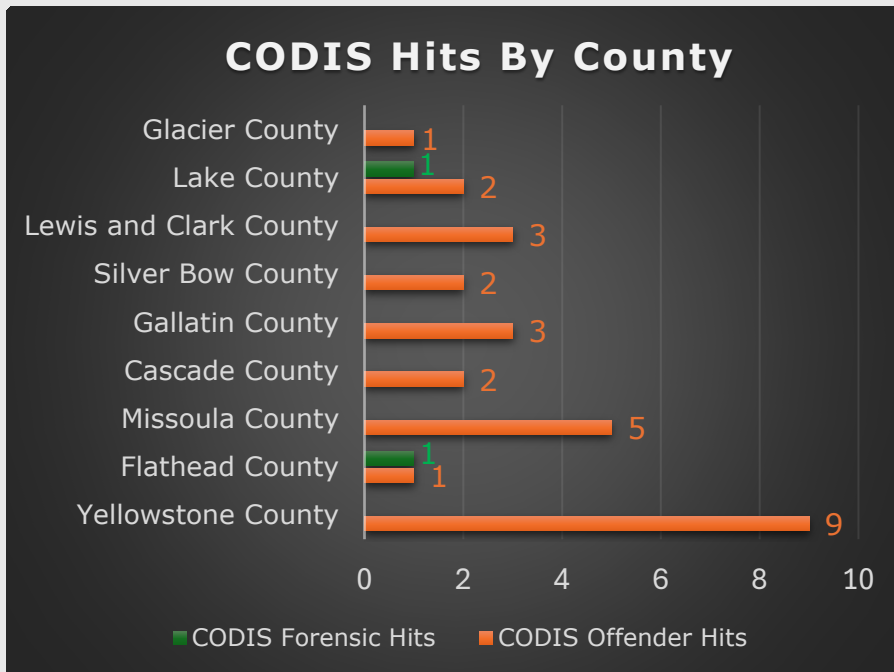

#### DEFINITIONS

\*Juvenile Victims are defined here as individuals under the age of 18

**SAKs:** Sexual Assault Kits

**CODIS:** Combined DNA Index System or CODIS is the United States national DNA database program used as a tool to link violent crimes.

- **Offender Hit:** DNA profile from a SAK or crime scene matches a known DNA profile of an offender or arrestee, possibly identifying a suspect.
- **Forensic Hit:** Two crimes become linked due to a DNA profile from one SAK or crime scene matching another.

**Incident Location:** Where the crime occurred.
