- Communicate and move in pairs if cover officer is present
- Target identification
- Use of force considerations

At the end of this program students will have the knowledge, mindset, and skills necessary to aggressively and effectively respond to an active shooter situation alone or in pairs.

INDIVIDUAL effectiveness.

-Have the confidence to answer what is important  
now (W.I.N.) to limit group think, bad muscle  
memory and going down the wrong “rabbit hole.”

-Save lives with a quick and tactically sound  
response.

-Be AGGRESSIVE; turn the odds in your favor.

-Interdict: best case scenario, time is of the essence.

-Interrupt: become a game changer and force  
decisions.
