



FY25 3rd Quarter Ending March 31, 2025


#### **Video Gambling Tax Collections**

Video Gambling Machine (VGM) tax collections for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY25 (January, February, March) were \$20.3M, a 4.5% decrease from 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY25 and a 1.4% decrease over 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24.



## **Liquor and Gambling License Applications**


In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY25, the Division received 87 gambling, liquor, and combined liquor/gambling applications (including amended applications). This is 18 less than the number of applications received during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY24 (18% decrease.) As of the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, there are approximately 1,315 active gambling operators in Montana.



#### **Video Gambling Machine Permits**


Effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013, an individual video gambling machine permit fee was increased to \$240 for the full fiscal year and is reduced by a prorated amount each subsequent quarter of the fiscal year. A portion of the fee goes to the local government where the machine is located, and the balance goes to the Gambling Special Revenue Fund.

During the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY25, 433 video gambling machines permits were issued. This is 144 less than 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24, a 25% decrease. The total permits issued in FY24 were 18,346 and the YTD total for FY25 are 17,600. There are currently 17,718 licensed VGMs in Montana.



## Live Bingo/Keno

• The total number of bingo and keno permits issued during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25 was 10, which is an11% increase over 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24 (9).



## **Special Event Permits**

 The Division processed 26 Casino Night permits during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25. This is 7 more permits processed than 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24.




 The Division processed 75 Calcutta permits during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25. This is same number that was issued during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24.



### **Live Card Games**

- The number of card tables permitted as of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25 is 185, this is a slight decrease compared to 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24 (193.)
- As of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25, the total number of licensed card dealers is 337. The total number of card dealers licensed during FY24 was 311.
- In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of FY25, 60 large-stakes tournament permits were issued. This is 12 more than the number of permits processed in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY24.
- The Division didn't issue any small-stakes permits in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter FY25.
