

OFFICER RESPONSE TO ACTIVE SHOOTER

This course is designed to give the individual Officer the appropriate skill set to respond to and address an active shooter event. Officers will also learn to work in a unit utilizing the most up to date tactics. This course will give the individual Officer multiple reps of executing the techniques along with one-on-one instructor feedback.

Gear List

- Full duty load out (plate carrier, belt, ect)
- Training clothing (BDU, Uniform, Tactical pants, LONG SLEEVE SHIRT)
- Clear eye protection
- Handgun weapons mounted light
- Flashlight
- Patrol Rifle if you have one (Remove suppressors prior to class)
- Go bag if you have one setup (Remove ammunition)
- Note taking material
- **NO HANDGUNS**

Do not show up to the class armed. Please leave all firearms inside your vehicles. If you are uncomfortable leaving a firearm in a vehicle arrangements can be made.

Course is hosted by the Billings Police Department at 4810 Midland Rd, BPD training facility. The course will take place August 5th to the 7th from 0800 hours to 1700 hours and is POST credit approved for 24 hours.
