




Video Gambling Tax Collections

Video Gambling Machine (VGM) tax collections for the second quarter of fiscal year 2014 (October, November, and December) were approximately \$13.89 million. That is a 1.0% decrease from the previous quarter, and a 1.1% decrease in collections from second quarter of fiscal year 2013. All VGM tax collections are deposited into the State General Fund.



Liquor and Gambling License Applications


In the second quarter of fiscal year 2014, the Division received 96 gambling, liquor, and combined liquor/gambling applications (including amended applications). This is 28 more (41% increase) than the number of applications received during second quarter of FY13, and 39% more than the number of applications received last quarter. This increase was attributable to amended applications for a unique situation and not indicative of a change in the trend. There are currently approximately 1,500 active Gambling Operator Licenses.



Video Gambling Machine Permits

Effective July 1st, 2013, an individual video gambling machine permit fee was increased to \$240 for the full fiscal year and is reduced by a prorated amount each subsequent quarter of the fiscal year. A portion of the fee goes to the local government where the machine is located and the balance goes to the Gambling Special Revenue Fund.

During the second quarter of fiscal year 2014, 537 video gambling machines were issued permits, approximately 37% less than second quarter of FY13.



Live Bingo/Keno

The total number of bingo and keno licenses issued through the second quarter of fiscal year 2014 was 85 (60 Commercial, 25 Exempt), which is the same number of licenses issued at this time last fiscal year.

Special Event Permits

- The division processed 38 Casino Night permits in fiscal year 2013 and has processed 14 through second quarter in fiscal year 2014.
- The division processed 124 Calcutta permits in fiscal year 2013, and has processed 84 so far through second quarter of fiscal year 2014.

Live Card Games

- By the end of second quarter, the number of card tables permitted during fiscal year 2014 was 249. This is 4.6% less than the same time last year.
- The number of card dealers licensed at the end of second quarter 2014 was 453, down 6% from the same time last year.
- By the end of second quarter 2014, 75 large-stakes tournament permits were issued.
- By the end of second quarter 2014, 13 small-stakes tournament permits were issued.
