



BUTTE AREA ONE RESTORATION PROJECT IDEA SUBMITTAL FORM

The Butte Natural Resource Damage Restoration Council (BNRC) is soliciting ideas for projects that would improve Butte-area natural resources, namely groundwater and surface water resources of Silver Bow Creek that were injured by mining and were the subject of the \$28.1 M claim recovered from ARCO. Appropriate ideas would focus on restoring or replacing injured groundwater and surface water resources or replacing the services that these resources provided, such as drinking water and fishing, etc. Do you have ideas about the restoration of the Butte Hill's natural resources or those of the surrounding areas? Then please share them with us by completing and submitting the form below by **Friday, April 20, 2012**. The BNRC will consider your ideas while preparing their draft Butte Area One Restoration Plan. The goal is to have this plan out for public review in fall 2012 and to the Governor by Dec. 2012 for his consideration.
