NOTICE OF DATA BREACH

Dear Former Employee of Borets U.S. Inc or Levare U.S. Inc,

We are writing to you because of an incident involving personal information stored on our internal servers that could have possibly been compromised due to a data breach by unknown parties. Although we are unaware of any actual misuse of your information, we are providing notice to you and about the incident, and about tools you can use to protect yourself against possible identity theft or fraud.

What Happened?

On August 2nd, 2023 we experienced a data breach of our internal services by an unknown group. The intruder or intruders placed malware on the servers, and by doing so gained access to our internal files stored on the servers. The attackers gained access to stored information including historical payroll files and because you previously were employed by Borets U.S. Inc or Levare U.S. Inc, we are notifying you about this data breach.

What Information Was Involved?

The information that the attacker potentially had access to includes your first and last name, your address, your social security number, and banking details.

What Are We Doing?

Our IT department has worked firm to remove the malware from our systems and is actively monitoring the platform to safeguard personal information. It is not clear what information was seen or downloaded but out of precaution we are notifying anyone potentially affected.

What You Can Do?

To protect yourself from the possibility of identity theft, we recommend you monitor you credit to and validate any new credit requests. In addition, review your banking statements and report any suspicious activity to the relevant financial institutions.
