Dear Valued Customer:

We are sending this notice to inform you that we recently detected an intrusion into the Golf18 Network payment system (a "Hack"). During the intrusion, an unauthorized third party (a "hacker") temporarily penetrated our checkout system and had access to the following personal information: name, mailing address, email address, phone number, and credit card details. The breach appears to have occurred over a three week period beginning on April 19th.

We have devoted all of our security resources to ensuring no additional information can be compromised. We can report that all possible areas of intrusion have been blocked and secured. In addition, all the appropriate legal authorities have been notified, as the protection of your information is of paramount importance to us.

At a minimum, we recommend you take the following steps:

- Contact your credit card or debit card issuer immediately
- Review your credit card statement

WE ALSO STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU ASK YOUR CREDIT CARD COMPANY TO DISABLE THIS CARD AND ISSUE YOU A NEW ONE.

It is important to remind you of a few best practices if you are ever contacted by a "credit card" company:

- 1. Never give out your banking information. If they are truly your credit card provider, they will not ask for this data.
- 2. Do not call any number left on your voicemail or texted to you. Instead, call the number listed on the back of your credit card.

For the disruption and inconvenience that this incident has caused you, a \$20 credit will be placed on your Golf18 Network account within one week.
