On April 30, 2019, we learned that an unauthorized individual may have accessed a single junior employee's email account that contained some of your personal information. Immediately, we took steps to secure the information in that email account and limit unauthorized access. We closed the only email account affected. At the same time, Eton instituted an internal review of the affected email account. Through Focus, Eton has access to the expertise of a cybersecurity IT firm that has completed a thorough forensic investigation. To help prevent a similar occurrence in the future, we have taken steps to further enhance our existing security protocols, including the use of multi-factor authentication, a state-of-the-art protection for online account access.

Recently, you may have noticed media reports regarding the increasing number of corporate data breaches. Bad actors are becoming increasingly more sophisticated in their hacking attempts. It takes considerable effort on the part of companies and their clients to thwart hackers' efforts. The Ponemon Institute's 2018 Cost of Data Breach study (sponsored by IBM) reported that, on the average, data breaches go undiscovered for 197 days, taking an additional 69 days to remediate.

Out of an abundance of caution, we are informing you that the affected email account contained a message with some of your personal information, including your name, address, «Personally_Identifiable_Information_PII». While our review provided no evidence that your information was either accessed or misused in any way, we want to proactively notify you regarding this matter.

Given the proliferation of cyberattacks, Eton will begin to offer a credit monitoring and protection program by Experian to our clients, at no additional cost. Eton will also help our clients freeze their credit information at the major credit bureaus.
