SEXUAL ASSAULT NURSE EXAMINER TRAINING

Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs) receive training in addressing the needs of individuals that have experienced sexual assault. SANEs are prepared to provide both trauma-informed medical care and evidence collection. Training includes learning to approach survivors with empathy and empowerment while gathering information that informs their care and possibly an investigation. If a SANE pursues International Association of Forensic Nursing SANE certification, this training will cover the didactic SANE course requirement.

Hybrid Training Model (Clinical training encouraged but not required)

40 Hours: Didactic Training (Virtual)

16 Hours: Clinical Training (choose from 4 sites)

Kalispell: May 6-7

Missoula: May 8-9

Helena: May 13-14

Bozeman: May 15-16

Participants taking the clinical training are required to complete a didactic training program prior to the clinical training date.
