# Gambling Control TAP GOA Live Gaming Permits Guide 



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## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## What live gaming permits are available?

Live Keno/Bingo, Live Card Table(s), Small Stakes Tournament, and Large Stakes Tournaments can be added to an existing and active Gambling Operator Account (GOA).

Note: MCA 23-5-119 Appropriate Alcoholic Beverage License for Certain Gambling Activities governs which parts of Title 23 , Chapter 5 licensees are allowed to offer.

## How long do these take for the division to process?

Large Stakes Card Tournaments are the only option that need to be proceeded by division personnel. These are required to be submitted at least 5 business days before the event per ARM 23.16.1102.

Live Card Tables, Live Keno/Bingo, and Small Stakes Tournaments are processed automatically after payment is submitted on TAP and you should receive an updated VGM Permit same day.

## Can I apply on TAP then mail payment?

Submitting the application on TAP requires payment in order to submit the application. If you would like to pay via check, please find the corresponding form on our forms page for the activity you would like to add and mail the check and completed application in together.

## What happens if my payment doesn't go through?

If your permit request is processed automatically by TAP and then payment fails to process, you will be contacted by the division to provide alternative payment.

Mont. Code Ann. §23-5-306 (1)(a) A person who has been granted an operator's license under 23-5-177 and a license to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises may be granted an annual permit for the placement of live card game tables.

Mont. Admin. R.23.16.1201(7) 'Card Table' or 'live card game table' means a table licensed by the department on which no more than one authorized card game is played at a time.

23.16.1103 SMALL-STAKES CARD GAME TOURNAMENTS
(1) A licensed operator with a permit to operate at least one live card game table on premises may apply to the department for an annual permit to conduct small-stakes card game tournaments. The application must be submitted on Form 14B, the small-stakes card game tournament permit application which is available from the department, or online via Montana's TransAction Portal. The annual permit fee must accompany submission of the application. The small-stakes card game tournament permit is effective July 1 through June 30.
(2) The only consideration that may be paid to participate in a small-stakes card game tournament is a single entry fee which must be paid before the start of the tournament, and may under no circumstances exceed $\$ 80$. No other fees or costs may be assessed to participate in a small-stakes tournament.
(3) Small-stakes card game tournaments may only be conducted on permitted card tables, plus one additional card table used only for small-stakes tournament play. (History: 23-5115, MCA; IMP, 23-5-317, MCA; NEW, 2013 MAR p. 1606, Eff. 10/1/13.)
c. If requesting a Keno and/or Bingo permit, hit Yes and check which games you'd like to offer. The Exemption Status will automatically populate based on division records.

Pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. §23-5-407(1) A person who has been granted an operator's license may be granted an annual permit by the department to conduct live bingo or keno games on specified premises. The permit expires June 30 of each year.

d. If applying for Live a Large Stakes Permit, hit Yes and complete all required information. You will see information displayed regarding how many tournaments have already been approved and if the annual permitting fee is required on this submission. Please note that if you are applying for your first tournament permit and additional permits on the same day the system will not yet acknowledge your payment and may indicate additional fees due. You are only required to pay one (1) $\$ 120$ annual permit fee for Large Stakes Tournaments per fiscal year (July 1 - June 30). Hit Next > to proceed.


6. Once you have selected the desired requests and completed the required information, hit Next $>$ at the bottom of the page.
7. The Fees page will show you the fee breakdown and total amount due. Hit Next $>$ to continue.

9. Complete the Authorization section. Hit Next > when ready to proceed. You will be required to enter your TAP password.
