

LEGAL NOTICE

New restrictions on the chemicals found in products marketed with street names such as *Spice Blends, Incense, Potpourri, Bath Salts, Plant Food, Glass Cleaner, etc...* take effect on October 1, 2013.

Evidence concerning these products must be sent to the State Crime Lab for positive identification. Crime Lab reports will direct readers to the relevant portion(s) of the MCA.

Reports for Synthetic Cannabinoids or “Fake Pot”

Analysis by gas chromatography/mass selective detector identified JWH-122, a synthetic cannabinoid listed in the Montana Code Annotated under 50-32-222(4)(kk)(i)(A).

Reports for Substituted Cathinones or “Bath Salts”

Analysis by gas chromatography/mass selective detector identified mephedrone, a substituted cathinone listed in the Montana Code Annotated under 50-32-222(4)(mm)(i).

DRUG ANALOGUES ARE NOW ILLEGAL!

"Dangerous drug analogue" means any material, compound, mixture, or preparation that is structurally related to or chemically derived from any dangerous drug in Schedules I through V... or that is expressly or impliedly represented to produce or does produce a physiological effect similar to or greater than the effect of a dangerous drug in Schedules I through V.
